## 'A Fan or a Follower'

I've recently started reading a book entitled Not a Fan by Kyle Idleman. The purpose of the book is to heighten awareness to the fact that Jesus is looking for followers and not fans.

So with that in mind, let me ask you a question: Are you a follower of Jesus?

I think most of us would quickly say 'Yes, I am'. Great! Now let me ask some follow up questions.

Are you more interested in forgiveness... or in repentance?

Are you more attracted to salvation... or to surrender?

Are you more concerned about happiness in life... or with death to self?

If our reasons for following Jesus do not include an emphasis upon words like repentance, surrender and death to self... then like it or not... Jesus would classify us as fans and not followers.

It's interesting to note that as Jesus walked the earth; He was continually challenging people to commit, to change, to repent, to surrender, to die to self, and to follow. In fact, it seemed as if the larger the crowd, the more challenging the message. After one of Jesus' teachings it says, 'From this time many of His disciples turned back and no longer followed Him.' (John 6:66) Many people in Jesus' day were 'Jesus fans' and not 'Jesus followers'.

Idleman puts it this way, '*Jesus was never interested in having fans... The biggest threat to the church today is fans who call themselves Christians but aren't actually interested in following Christ. They want to be close enough to Jesus to get all the benefits, but not so close that it requires anything of them.*'

Idleman goes on to say, '*Most of us don't mind Jesus making some minor changes in our lives, but Jesus wants to turn our lives upside down. Fans don't mind Him doing a little touch-up work, but Jesus wants complete renovation. Fans come to Jesus thinking tune-up, but Jesus is thinking overhaul. Fans think a little makeup is fine, but Jesus is thinking makeover. Fans think a little decorating is required, but Jesus wants a complete remodel. Fans want Jesus to inspire them, but Jesus wants to interfere with their lives.*'

Being a follower of Jesus means that we give Jesus complete permission to renovate, overhaul and remodel our lives. Being a follower means that we not only commit to believing in Jesus with our minds, but we commit to following after Him with our lives.

Over the past months, I have a growing sense of belief that God desires to use our church to influence our community. I believe that 5-10 years from now, our community can be visibly different as a result of what God does in us and through us. The only way this will take place is if we as God's church move from a place of cheering in the stands, to actively engaging in the game. There are lots of ways we can do this. Let me mention just a few: prayer walk your neighborhood; share your faith with a friend; get involved in a community group; commit to shop in town; no more littering; join or start a small group; commit to attend church regularly; read your Bible daily – not out of guilt or habit but because you want to hear from God and will commit to following God. I could go on, but I think you are getting the idea.

Jesus has plenty of fans... many of whom are fair weathered. What He is really looking for... is a few wholehearted men, women, teenagers and children who are willing to commit everything to Him. This is a follower. This is a Christian.

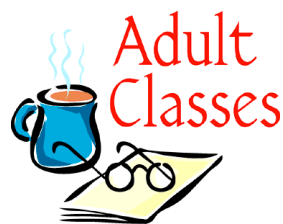

## Updates and Prayer Requests from our Missionaries

### MALI UPDATE

On March 22 members of the Malian military who were not satisfied with the way the government was handling unrest in the north of the country launched a coup d'état. The uncertainty was elevated by the fact that the coup leaders were not willing to reinstate the constitutional rule in a timely manner, so for several days Mali's neighbors enforced sanctions by closing their borders. Last week the coup leaders handed over power to a civilian government, though it seems the coup leaders plan to remain very involved. Mali has an interim president who is supposed to plan elections within 40 days. In the days that followed the coup, Tuareg rebels took control of the 3 major northern cities: Timbuktu, Gao, and Kidal. There are disturbing reports about what happened and the current state of things there, and many have fled those cities. The rebel group wants independence, but the other Muslim group that has worked with the rebels prefers that Mali remain united, and that sharia law be introduced across the country. Almost all of the international workers in Mali temporarily evacuated 2 weeks ago. Thank you for your continued prayers for Mali...there are many uncertainties and challenges ahead for this landlocked country on the edge of the desert.

Pray for the protection of the Malian people and for extra food and supplies to help those that have fled from the north to Bamako.
